The Taoist Festival Chiao, Festival of Community Renewal, recorded on this videotape, was performed in Honolulu at the Wong-tin Tin-hu Temple on Kuakini Street, from December 12-16, 1979. Local Chinese had invited the Chuang brothers from Hsinchu City to perform the rituals. They are the same brothers who appear in Saso's book on the Teachings of Taoist Master Chuang.
